Lake Perris currently does not have an algal bloom advisory in place; however, we have not started our monitoring season yet so I do not have any toxin sample data. Lake Perris may have a few localized areas of algal bloom activity according to the [HAB satellite analysis tool](#) , but overall the lake looks good (the blue and green pixels are where the satellite detected cyanobacteria, and the black pixels are where it was not detected). Here is a link to the State Water Board's [Healthy Water Habits](#) that are a general good practice if anyone suspects that an algal bloom may be present.
